Beginning Sunday, December 29th, we will have indoor flying opportunities every Sunday until the 16th of March. We will be using two venues, St. Peter's Lutheran Church Gym on the corner of 4th street and Chestnut in Columbus and a CERALand Gym, southeast of Columbus. From the junction of US 31 and State Road 9/46, go east to the second road to the right. There is a sign. Turn right and go .5 mile to CERALand.

Matt Hanley has once again secured indoor flying sessions for the 2013-14 indoor season at...

***The Gathering Place is conveniently located 4 miles west from Interstate 65.
The nearest intersection to the west is SR 135 (Meridian Street) and Main Street.***

***Each session will be three hours in duration for a cost of only \$15 per pilot.
Anyone with CURRENT AMA may fly at these sessions... spectators are welcome!***

This season, all of the flying sessions will be using (3) side-by-side basketball courts, except for the 11/23 and 12/14 sessions, which will be on the soccer court.

****** Soft-soled shoes are required to prevent any damage to the basketball courts ******

Helicopters will be limited to 250 sized (for normal flying) or MCPX sized (for 3D flying).
