OLD BUSINESS

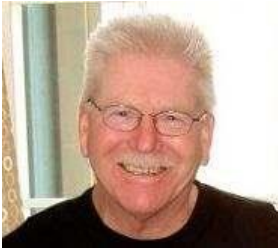
1. None

I've heard we've had at least two incidents this year already regarding flying heli's at our field. The wording on field rule #11 has been revised to eliminate most all questions that should come up. Remember a little COMMON SENCE and COURTECY goes a long way in avoiding many problems. Most people only fly 4 – 8 minutes per flight; the best solution might be to give them the sky for their flight to avoid any conflicts. We're all in this hobby to relax and enjoy both the flying and our friendships with our fellow flyers; so, RELAX & ENJOY 😊😊😊.

RULE #11: Heli's & multi-rotor aircraft are permitted and should follow any current flight pattern. Maintenance flights/hovering should be done **ONLY** in the designated area southwest of runway (heli pad).

June 21st has been set for our field clean-up/fix-up/get ready for flying season day. Let's have a good turn-out so the work gets done early and we can FLY!!!!

Let's not forget: the last member to leave the field has to make sure the frequency shed/club house and restrooms are locked and secure.
