The skills and abilities of the pilots were beyond belief. The airplanes fly at over 200 MPH and during the noontime air show one pilot hit 265 MPH on a forth diving attempt. These guys could bring these planes down to three to five feet above the ground and I know they were exceeding 200 MPH. Some of them had a flight envelope of over half a mile long. This is definitely at the high end of the hobby and there were pilots and planes there from all over the world.
