1. Denny Runge reported on the Swap Meet – had a good turn out and club made some money.

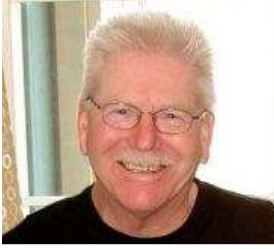
NEW BUSINESS
